Navigators Knock Wildcats Off Course

The Lincoln North Star and Millard West boys basketball teams were headed in different directions coming into their game Thursday night at The Swamp.

The Navigators showed they might be turning things around at just the right time with a 61-45 home victory in their next-to-last regular-season game before districts.

Both teams played zone defense in the first half and was played at a slow, deliberate pace.

West got off to an early 8-3 lead behind three-pointers by Chris Connell and Austin Harris. Another 3-pointer by Brock Burling at the buzzer gave the Wildcats a 16-12 lead at the end of the first quarter.

North Star converted on 6 of their first 8 possessions of the 2nd quarter. Back-to-back 3-pointers gave the Navi-

gators a 27-23 lead with 2:43 left in the half. A basket off of an offensive rebound at the buzzer gave North Star a 29-25 lead at the half.

"We didn't seem to have much energy on defense in the first half," Coach Bill Morrison said. "And, for some reason, their zone gave us a lot of trouble in the first half."

North Star outscore West 15-12 in the third quarter. The Navigators built a 36-29 lead early in the 2nd half. West was able to score, but was not able to keep the Navigators from scoring.

West switched to a man-to-man defense in the final period, and the Navigators started to attack the basket. Donny William was 9 of 15 from the line in the 4th quarter as he scored 13 points in the period to help

the Navigators pull away from the Wildcats.

Williams finished with 31 for North Star and Alex Goll added 12.

"We didn't do a very good job on Williams when we switched to man. We didn't help soon enough and ended up fouling him," Coach Morrison said.

Brock Burling was the only Wildcat in double digits with 13 points.

Bearcats Spoil Senior Night

Kearney used a 23-14 3rd quarter to build a comfortable lead on Senior Night at Millard West.

The Wildcats would not be able to narrow the Bearcat lead in the 4th quarter as Kearney won 66-54.

Kanon Koster led three Bearcats in double digits with 23 points. Seth Stroh and Carson Schwarz added 18 and 12 for KHS.

Brock Burling led the Wildcats with 20 points. Chris Connell also scored 13 points.

Scoring was hard to come by early in the game. Two free throws by Schwarz gave Kearney a 6-4 lead with 4:33 left in the 1st quarter. The Bearcats led 13-7 before Burling scored 4 points to end the quarter and close the lead to 13-11.

West battled to take a lead in the 2nd quarter. Another basket by Burling tied the score at 23-23 with 2:10 left in the period. A three pointer by Giavonni Guido gave West a 27-23 lead going into the half.

"I think our Seniors were a little emotional early and did not play relaxed in the first quarter," Coach Bill Morrison said. "We relaxed in the 2nd quarter and did a good job of battling back."

Kearney came out of the half scoring 13 points in their first five possessions while holding the Wildcats scoreless. The Bearcats led 38-27 after just two minutes of the 2nd half.

"The 3rd quarter has been a problem for us all season. We need to figure that out for districts," Coach Morrison said.

West battled back again and cut the score to 43-41 with 1:05 left in the quarter. Kearney scored 5 points in the last minute to gain a 48-41 lead going into the 4th quarter.

West was not able to get any closer than six points in the final period. Koster took control of the game and scored 10 points in the 4th quarter.
