#### Prep Attacks Early, Eliminates Wildcats

Top-ranked Creighton Prep heeded its coach's pregame message entering Monday's District A-2 championship game.

"We talked before the game that we needed to be like sharks in the water with that red meat around," Creighton Prep coach Josh Luedtke said. "We had to be the aggressor, the more attacking team."

The Junior Jays were that right from the tip as they opened a 24-point halftime lead in rolling to an 81-56 win over Millard West.

Defense set the tone. Prep led 6-0 50 seconds into the game as Akol Arop scored a layin on the opening possession, then Jaylin Hunter had back-to-back layups after steals.

By the midway point of the first

quarter, Prep had forced six turnovers, scored five baskets in transition and led 15-3.

"The defensive intensity was the most impressive thing to me tonight," Luedtke said. "These guys were unbelievable tonight with their effort and focus early in the game."

After that early burst, 6-foot-7 senior Jayden Temme heated up.

The Benedictine commit hit four 3-pointers and had 14 points in the opening quarter. Temme, who entered the night averaging 11.6 points per game, finished 6 of 11 from behind the arc and scored a career-high 30 points.

"I have great teammates and they know when to find the hot shooter. Tonight it was me," Temme said. Prep scored 12 straight points late in the first half to build a 47-23 halftime lead. The Junior Jays led by at least 20 throughout the second half.

Arop punctuated that 12-0 run with an alley-oop dunk. Temme threw the pass from behind the 3-point line and Arop grabbed it with his right hand and threw it down.

"I thought it was a bad lob and all of a sudden he grabs it with one hand," Temme said with a smile.

Arop, who sat out the previous two games to heal an injury, and Hunter each added 14 points. Prep shot 58 percent from the field as a team.

Chris Connell led three Millard West players in double figures with 13 points.

Creighton Prep, which has won 15 straight, heads to state for the fourth straight year and looks for its first title since 2015.

"We've had some real big wins down the stretch and we're playing good defense. That's kind of been our weakness this year," Temme said.
