Wildcats Move to 4-1 with 78-60 Over Lincoln High

Millard West jumped out to another big lead in the first quarter on their way to 78060 victory over Lincoln High.

Evan Meyersick led the team with 17 points, 7 rebounds and 3 steals. Ryan Larsen added 16 points, 5 rebounds, 4 assists, and 5 steals. James Conway scored 11 points.

Lincoln High was led by JR and Gatran Gatnoor with 12 and 23 points respectively.

The Wildcats started fast and led 14-4 with 4:12 left in the first quarter. Lincoln High committed 8 turnovers in the first quarter. G. Gatnoor hit a 3-pointer at the buzzer to make the score 27-9.

Larsen had 11 of his points in the first quarter and Conway scored 6 for the Wildcats.

West forced the Links into seven more turnovers in the 2nd quarter. They build a 39-19 lead with 3 minutes left in the half.

Dom Humm and Meyersick both scored five points in the quarter as the Wildcats took a 42-28 lead into the half.

West's defense dominated the 3rd quarter. Lincoln High committed 9 more turnovers in the period as the Wildcats outscored the Links 19-11 in the quarter.

"At the half, we talked about how we had had a bad quarter in each of our three wins. The 2nd quarter felt the same way," Coach Bill Morrison said. "We wanted our guys to come out in the third quarter the same way they did in the fist quarter."

A basket by Chase Hultman with 4:50 eft in the game gave West their biggest lead of the game, 70-41. Seven different Wildcats scored in the final period on their way to the 78-60 victory.

West had another solid team effort . The Wildcats recorded 28 assists in the game.

"West has a nice team that plays the right way," Lincoln High Coach Dan Noble said after the game.
