## Kearney Tops Wildcats in Last Regular Season Game

KEARNEY — 6-foot-8 senior, Shilo Robinson notched his 14th double-double this season with a 26-point, 10-rebound performance in Kearney's 75-58 victory over Millard West on Friday night at Kearney High.

Besides Robinson, Carson Schwarz and Jack Johnson each tallied 12 points to lead the Bearcats' offense.

The Wildcats were able to break the Bearcat press for lay ups and forced a timeout about two minutes into the game.

After the timeout, the Bearcats (19-4) used an inside-out approach and rallied to score 14 of the next 16 points to hold a 20-10 advantage with two minutes left in the first quarter.

Millard West (10-11) pulled within six points in the second period but couldn't keep up with the Bearcats. Seth Stroh's 3-pointer at the first-half buzzer gave the Bearcats a 39-27 advantage.

Kearney used a 14-8 run in the middle of the 3rd quarter to pull away from Millard West. The Bearcats led

by as many as 23 points in the second half.

Robinson played a critical role in holding Millard West to 45 percent shooting. He was a force inside and made it difficult for the Wildcats to drive to the hoop, finishing with five blocks.

Evan Meyersick led Millard West with 12 points and Kaedyn Odermann added 10.

"With Shiloh at the rim, it's hard because, even if you get by your guy, he's right there," Millard West coach

Bill Morrison said. "They do a lot of double teams with him too. He's hard to get around. I thought our guys handled the pressure well, but he changed a lot of our shots."


